



Take Me Home is a database that is maintained at the Ascension Parish Sheriff's Office for people who may need special assistance communicating with first responders. This free and voluntary system gives community members of Ascension Parish an opportunity to provide a picture, demographic information, and caregiver contacts to the Sheriff's Office in case of an emergency.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Take Me Home Alert based on address and person - person's name, address, and photo are entered into the the computer-aided dispatch system as a participant in the Take Me Home program

- When a call for service is received at that address, the 911 dispatcher will see an "alert" on their screen and provide information to the first responders
- When needed, 911 dispatchers can make a query based on the details provided to help identify unknown people with special needs or who are unable to communicate with first responders
- The photo and information can be shared with the first responders
